

GCE A-Levels

Cambridge International AS and A Levels
Qualifications are internationally benchmarked
qualifications providing excellent preparation for
university education. A-levels is the 'Gold
Standard' of Cambridge International Examination
Qualifications. It has the same value in admitting
students to all the universities as its UK
equivalent. It is a globally recognized entry
qualification by universities all around the world.

A-level is a rigorous programme that demands high academic standards. The program offers highly flexible subject combinations. Students



may choose any combination from the wide array of subjects that suit their interest, aptitude, and career ambitions. The two-year course exposes, nourishes and hones the creativity and latent potential of a student there by developing their analytical skills.

Examination System

The A and AS level final examinations are held twice a year in May/June and October/November while results of the examinations are normally published in August and January respectively.

Grading System

Students are required to take at least four subjects with 3.5 credits, which includes a compulsory subject, English General Paper of half credit. They may also take more than required credits depending upon their interests and capabilities. Students are assessed on a grade scale from A* to E and U. A* is awarded for the highest level of achievement, whereas, E indicates the minimum required performance, and U stands for ungraded which means failure to complete the required performance.





Eligibility for the A-Level

Students who have taken the SEE/GCSE/CBSE or other equivalent courses at the time of admission can apply for A-levels programme. The main requirement is academic ability to fulfill the rigors of this challenging programme. Malpi Institute uses a comprehensive evaluation system to select a highly motivated group of students to join the programme.

Malpi Scholarships

The college offers scholarships to highly meritorious but financially weak students. There are limited numbers of scholarships for deserving candidates. Candidates for MI scholarships need to prove that they are financially deserving and academically capable to show ability to achieve the top grades.

Duke of Edinburgh's International Awards

Malpi Institute is now part of the Duke of Edinburgh's International Award, which is one of the prestigious awards for non-formal education and learning. The Award challenges and motivates young people aged 14 to 26, to dream big, celebrate their achievements, and make a difference in their world. The Award develops transferable skills, increasing their fitness levels, cultivating a sense of adventure and volunteering in their community, the Award helps young people to find their purpose, passion, and place in the world.

Almost 30% of our students who apply to a foreign country go to top universities in Australia and Thailand.
